MEDICAL QUALIFICATION

Department of Defense Medical Exam Review Board (DoDMERB)

DEADLINE: April 15th

You must take and pass the full DoDMERB medical evaluation.

- Screening process may take 2 4 months
- If disqualified by DoDMERB, medical waivers may be considered for competitive candidates
- Medical waiver requests are then evaluated by USMA medical professionals for final determination

NOMINATIONS

CONGRESSIONAL

- Each member of congress may nominate up to 10 prospective candidates.
- Every candidate is eligible for:
 - 1x Congressional Representative
 - 2x Senators
 - Vice President
- Every congressional office has different nomination requirements.

SERVICE-CONNECTED

- Children of career military
- Children of veterans who are 100% disabled or are deceased
- Enlisted members of the U.S. Army and U.S. Army Reserve
- ROTC and JROTC*

*Non-Army JROTC must be Honor Unit of Distinction

A nomination does NOT guarantee admittance.
