## MILITARY \& CIVILIAN COMPARISON

| Pay | Earn bi weekly basic and special pay that is comparable with civilian pay. |

| Healthcare | TRICARE offers a range of full coverage medical and dental plans, as well as prescription drug coverage at a very low cost. |
| Housing | The Army provides with you on base housing. For Soldiers who live off base, the Army provides a basic allowance for housing which is tax free. |
| Insurance | $\$ 500,000$ of comprehensive life insurance for Soldiers and $\$ 100,000$ for spouses, both for a very low monthly fee. |
| Education | In service Tuition Assistance with college courses taught on base or remotely. G.I. Bill for Soldiers who leave the service. |
| Travel | Opportunities to travel to various locations during your time in service. "Space A" travel and discounted travel opportunities. |
| Paid Time Off | Earn 30 days of vacation per year ( 2.5 days per month) + Federal holidays. |
| Work hours | Most of the time its similar to civilian jobs. Occasionally work weekends. |
| Opportunities for advancement | Professional development is emphasized from the very first day you put the uniform on. You are in control if you want to advance or not |
| Retirement | Eligible to retire after 20 years of active duty/Reserve service. |
| Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) | Generously discounted support and leisure services designed to enhance the lives of Soldiers \& their families. |

2-4 year scholarship options

Active duty or Reserve option

- ROTC SIMULTANEOUS MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM (SMP) Serve in the Reserves AND attend ROTC classes simultaneously.
Commission upon graduation.
- MINUTE MAN SCHOLARSHIP

2-4 year scholarship options

- 100\% full tuition \& fees OR \$10,000 in room \& board
- \$1,200 yearly book stipend
- \$420 monthly allowance for personal expenses
