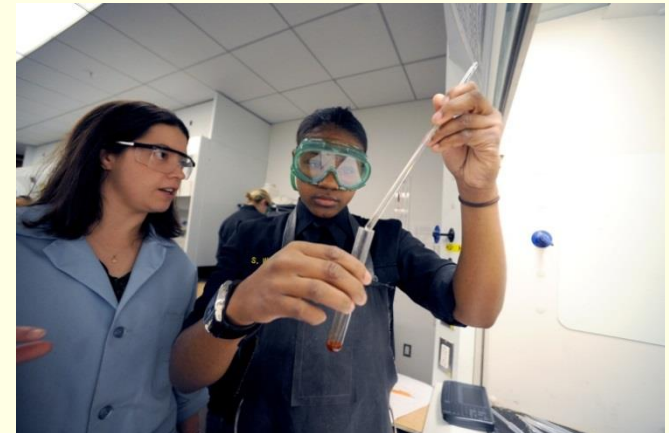

- Minimum 5 year service commitment

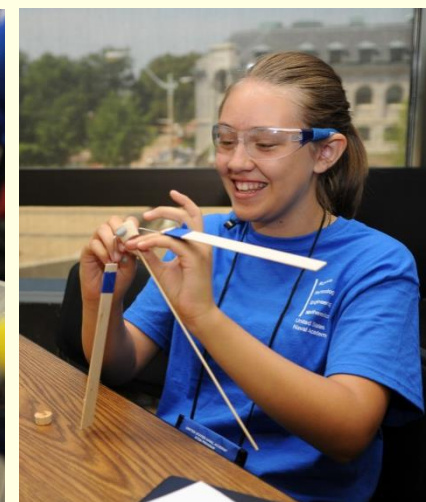
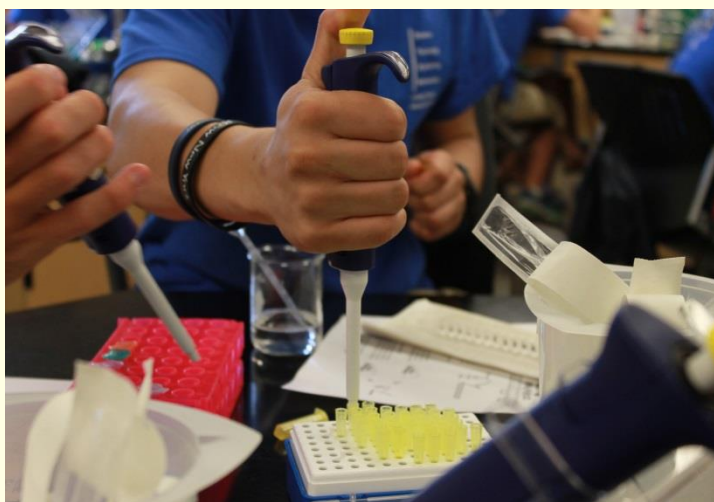




# STEM - SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, MATHEMATICS

- Hands-on academic program exposing rising 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students to the possibility of a STEM career

- At least 17 years of age and must not have passed 23rd birthday on July 1st of year of entry
- United States Citizen by I-Day
- Unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support a child or other individual

# MEDICAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Department of Defense Medical Examination Review Board (DoDMERB) schedules medical exams for all officer accessions
- Admissions will make a determination as to if/when your name will be sent to DoDMERB for your medical based on the progression of activity toward completing your application, in conjunction with your competitiveness.
- Status reported to candidate & Office of Admissions
- Each Service Academy/officer accession program has different standards for entry



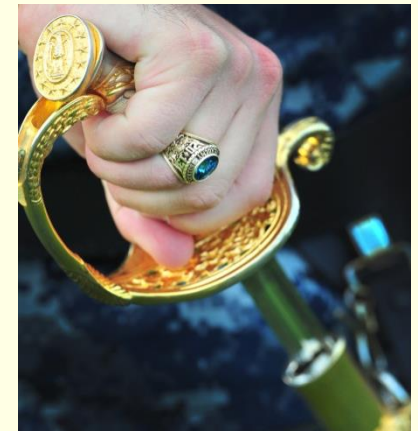
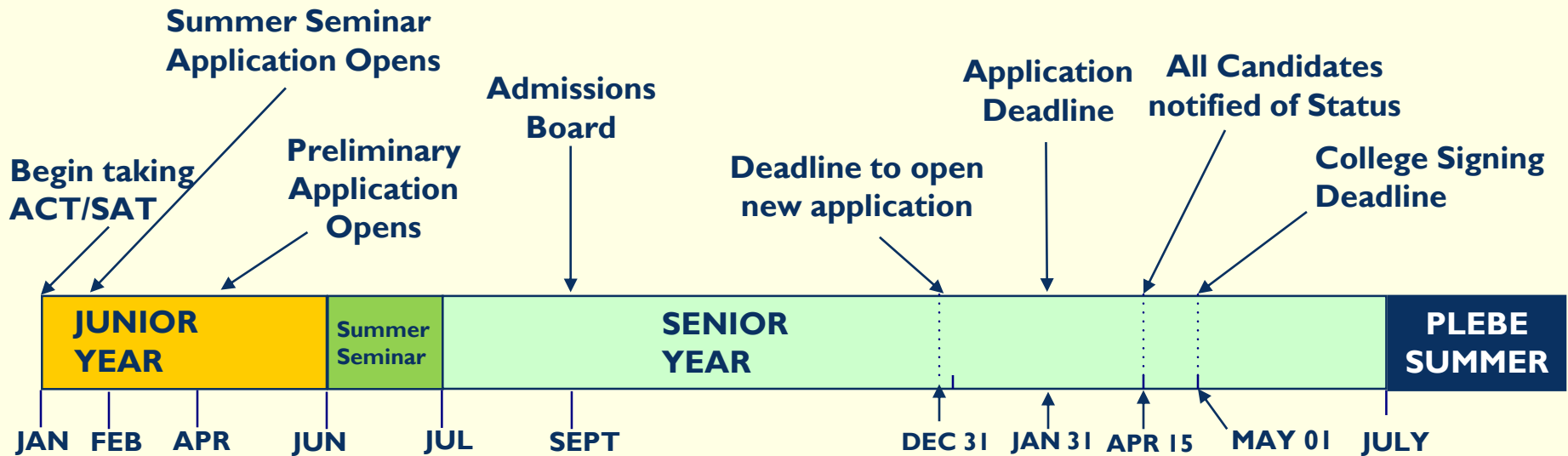


# NOMINATIONS

  - Congressional Representative (or delegates to Congress for students residing in US territories only)

# ADVICE FOR ADMISSIONS

## Strong Foundation in Math and Science

- Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus & Calculus
- Chemistry and Physics (with a lab if possible)

## No minimum GPA

- Strive to be in at least the top 20% of your high school class

## Take your SAT/ACT early and often (No minimum)

## AP/Honors/IB Courses are encouraged

## Well-rounded

- Demonstrated leadership potential
- Active in athletic and non-athletic activities

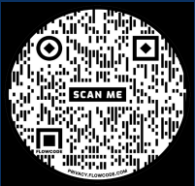
